The Lubbock Area Foundation

The Lubbock Area Foundation is an independent, non-profit, publicly supported, tax-exempt organization founded in 1981 to help donors meet the existing and future needs of the area's educational, health, cultural, civic and charitable organizations. The Foundation's scope goes beyond social service and welfare; our donors are improving the overall quality of life in the South Plains area.

The Lubbock Area Foundation administers a variety of charitable funds. Recognizing the importance of scholarships, especially with decreasing dollars for education at the federal level and increasing educational costs for students, the Foundation is pleased to administer the *Lubbock Art Association Scholarship Fund*, which is described below.

The Lubbock Art Association Scholarship Fund

Founded in 1951, the Lubbock Art Association was a community based visual arts organization that played an active role in promoting the fine arts and art education in the South Plains region until its dissolution in 2003. In furthering the Association's efforts to strengthen the importance of the fine arts in this region for artists and art lovers, the Lubbock Art Association Scholarship Fund awards are made to talented young artists so they may continue their art education at the post-secondary level.

Eligibility Requirements:

Without discrimination toward race or sex, the following eligibility requirements shall apply to candidates for the Lubbock Art Association Scholarship:

1. Student must be a graduating senior of a Lubbock County high school.
2. Student must have high school credits in advanced art courses.
3. Student must be planning to continue their education in an arts related field.
4. The scholarship advisory committee or Foundation staff may interview student.

Selection Process:



1. All scholarship applications must be completed in full and submitted to the Lubbock Area Foundation no later than 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 18th, 2007.
2. Artwork must be hand delivered on Wednesday, April 18th from 12 p.m. – 6 p.m. to the Lubbock Arts Festival at the Lubbock Memorial Civic Center, 1501 Mac Davis Lane. The art must then be picked up on Saturday, April 22nd after 5:00p.m.
3. The Scholarship Advisory Committee will view artwork and review completed applications and make recommendations for scholarship awards to the Lubbock Area Foundation Board of Directors. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
4. The Board of Directors of the Lubbock Area Foundation will review the recommendations of the Scholarship Advisory Committee and make final decisions in May.

Scholarship Fund Disbursement:

1. An annual one-time award will be made prior to the beginning of the Fall semester.
2. Scholarship payments will be made directly to the school in which the student is enrolling and may be used for tuition, fees and books only. Any funds remaining at the end of the year for which the scholarship was intended must be returned to the Lubbock Area Foundation.

Application Procedures:

In addition to the application, the following is required:

1. Up to three original works must be submitted for showing in the Lubbock Art Association Scholarship Art Show (see attached information sheet).
2. Letter of recommendation from an art teacher who has instructed you.
3. High School transcript
4. A copy of the letter of acceptance from the applicant's college or university should be submitted with the application if possible, or immediately upon receipt of such acceptance.
5. The applicant should complete the application by typing or printing all answers.
6. The application must be completed in full and submitted by **April 18th**.
7. Applications that are not complete will not be eligible for consideration.

Lubbock Art Association Scholarship Fund *Scholarship Art Show*

Eligibility: Entries may be two or three-dimensional, original works of high school seniors graduating from a Lubbock County high school in the current school year. Students must be planning to further their education in an arts related field. Works must have been completed within the last two years. Copies from published photographs or other paintings and designs are not eligible. Students may enter a maximum of three works. **Each artist must submit a completed Lubbock Art Association Scholarship application form.** For an application form visit us on the web at <http://www.lubbockareafoundation.org/pdfs/ARTassocapp.pdf> or call 762-8061.

Specifications: Paintings and other two-dimensional artwork should be framed and ready for hanging. No saw tooth hangers please. The artist's name, telephone number, title of piece, and sales price (if you wish to sell your piece) must be attached to the back of the artwork.

Delivery: Artwork should be hand-delivered on Wednesday, April 18th from 12p.m. –6 p.m. to the Lubbock Arts Festival at the Lubbock Memorial Civic Center, 1501 Mac Davis Lane. Scholarship applications are due at the Lubbock Area Foundation; 1655 Main Street, Suite 202; Lubbock, TX 79401 no later than Wednesday, April 18th at 5:00 p.m.

Entry Requirements: There is no entry fee or gallery fee for this event. Entries must remain for the duration of the show unless sold. The Scholarship Committee has the right to reject pieces that contain distasteful subject matter.

Return of Entries: Artists must reclaim their work on Sunday April 22nd after 5 p.m. at the Lubbock Memorial Civic Center, 1501 Mac Davis Lane.

Liability: The Lubbock Area Foundation and Lubbock Arts Alliance will take all reasonable precautions in protecting all works of art presented for the show; however, artists must assume all risk for damage or loss.
